

## Irregular conditional stems

### Aller (to go), conditional stem is **ir**

J' <b>irais</b>	I would go
Tu <b>irais</b>	You (informal) would go
Il/elle/on <b>irait</b>	He/she/we (informal) would go
Nous <b>irions</b>	We would go
Vous <b>iriez</b>	You (formal or plural) would go
Ils/Elles <b>iraient</b>	They would go

### Faire – to do, to make, conditional stem is **fer**

Je <b>ferais</b>	I would do/make
Tu <b>ferais</b>	You (informal) would do/make
Il/elle/on <b>ferait</b>	He/she/we (informal) would do/make
Nous <b>ferions</b>	We would do/make
Vous <b>feriez</b>	You (formal or plural) would do/make
Ils/Elles <b>feraient</b>	They would do/make

### Avoir – to have, conditional stem is **aur**

J' <b>aurais</b>	I would have
Tu <b>aurais</b>	You (informal) would have
Il/elle/on <b>aurait</b>	He/she/ we (informal) would have
Nous <b>aurions</b>	We would have
Vous <b>auriez</b>	You (formal or plural) would have
Ils/Elles <b>auraient</b>	They would have

## Être – to be, conditional stem is **ser**

Je <b>serais</b>	I would be
Tu <b>serais</b>	You (informal) would be
Il/elle/on <b>serait</b>	He/she/we (informal) would be
Nous <b>serions</b>	We would be
Vous <b>seriez</b>	You (formal or plural) would be
Ils/elles <b>seraient</b>	They would be

## Vouloir – to want. Conditional stem is **voudr**

Je <b>voudrais</b>	I would want (like)
Tu <b>voudrais</b>	You (informal) would want (like)
Il/elle/on <b>voudrait</b>	He/she/we (informal) would want (like)
Nous <b>voudrions</b>	We would want (like)
Vous <b>voudriez</b>	You (formal or plural) would want (like)
Ils/elles <b>voudraient</b>	They would want (like)

## Devoir – to have to, conditional stem is **devr**

Je <b>devrais</b>	I would have to
Tu <b>devrais</b>	You (informal) would have to
Il/elle/on <b>devrait</b>	He/she/we (informal) would have to
Nous <b>devrions</b>	We would have to
Vous <b>devriez</b>	You (formal or plural) would have to
Ils/Elles <b>devraient</b>	They would have to

## Pouvoir – to be able to, conditional stem is **pour**

Je <b>pourrais</b>	I would be able to
Tu <b>pourrais</b>	You (informal) would be able to
Il/elle/on <b>pourrait</b>	He/she/we (informal) would be able to
Nous <b>pourrions</b>	We would be able to
Vous <b>pourriez</b>	You (formal or plural) would be able to
Ils/Elles <b>pourraient</b>	They would be able to

## Savoir – to know, conditional stem is **saur**

Je <b>saurais</b>	I would know
Tu <b>saurais</b>	You (informal) would know
Il/elle/on <b>saurait</b>	He/she/we (informal) would know
Nous <b>saurions</b>	We would know
Vous <b>sauriez</b>	You (formal or plural) would know
Ils/elles <b>sauraient</b>	They would know

## Voir – to see, conditional stem is **verr**

Je <b>verrais</b>	I would see
Tu <b>verrais</b>	You (informal) would see
Il/elle/on <b>verrait</b>	He/she/we (informal) would see
Nous <b>verrions</b>	We would see
Vous <b>verriez</b>	You (formal or plural) would see
Ils/Elles <b>verraient</b>	They would see
