### TRANSCRIPTION

#### Français+anglais

- A. Qu'est-ce que tu ferais si tu gagnais au loto ?
- A. What would you do if you won the lottery?

- B. Ah, that's a good question... I think I'd buy my parents a nice house, and you?
- A. Je pense que je partirais faire un tour du monde. J'en ai toujours rêvé.
- A. I think I'd go on a round-the-world trip. It's always been a dream of mine.
- B. Moi j'aimerais aussi soutenir des associations qui aident les gens et les animaux.
- B. I'd also like to support charities that help people and animals.
- A. Oui, bonne idée. Et tu continuerais à travailler ?
- A. Yes, that's a good idea. And you would continue to work?
- B. Peut-être de temps en temps pour le plaisir... j'aurais peur de m'ennuyer !
- B. Maybe once in a while just for fun... I'd be afraid of getting bored!
- A. Oui je comprends. C'est beau de rêver !
- A. Yes, I understand. It's nice to dream!

## RAPPEL

To talk about a hypothetical situation in French, you can use the following combination

: Si + imperfect + conditional

Example : Si tu gagnais au loto, qu'est-ce que tu ferais ?

If you won the lottery what would you do?

Note that the conditional can move around in the sentence, but the imperfect will always be following "si".

Example : Qu'est-ce que tu ferais si tu gagnais au loto ?

What would you do if you won the lottery?
