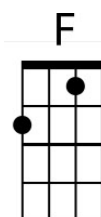
Verse 1

G7 But we know she's only putting on the C style.



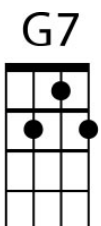
Chorus
